You would be taking information off the phone system and appointing a club to take care of the glasses in the area where the person lives. The State of CA has made cuts in Vision and Dental coverage for Medical over 21 years of age. Due to these cuts there has been an increase need for glasses. **If interested or know of someone that is interested in helping please contact someone on the board.**
